- **View Per Chapters:** The books are grouped by their [chapter pages](#).

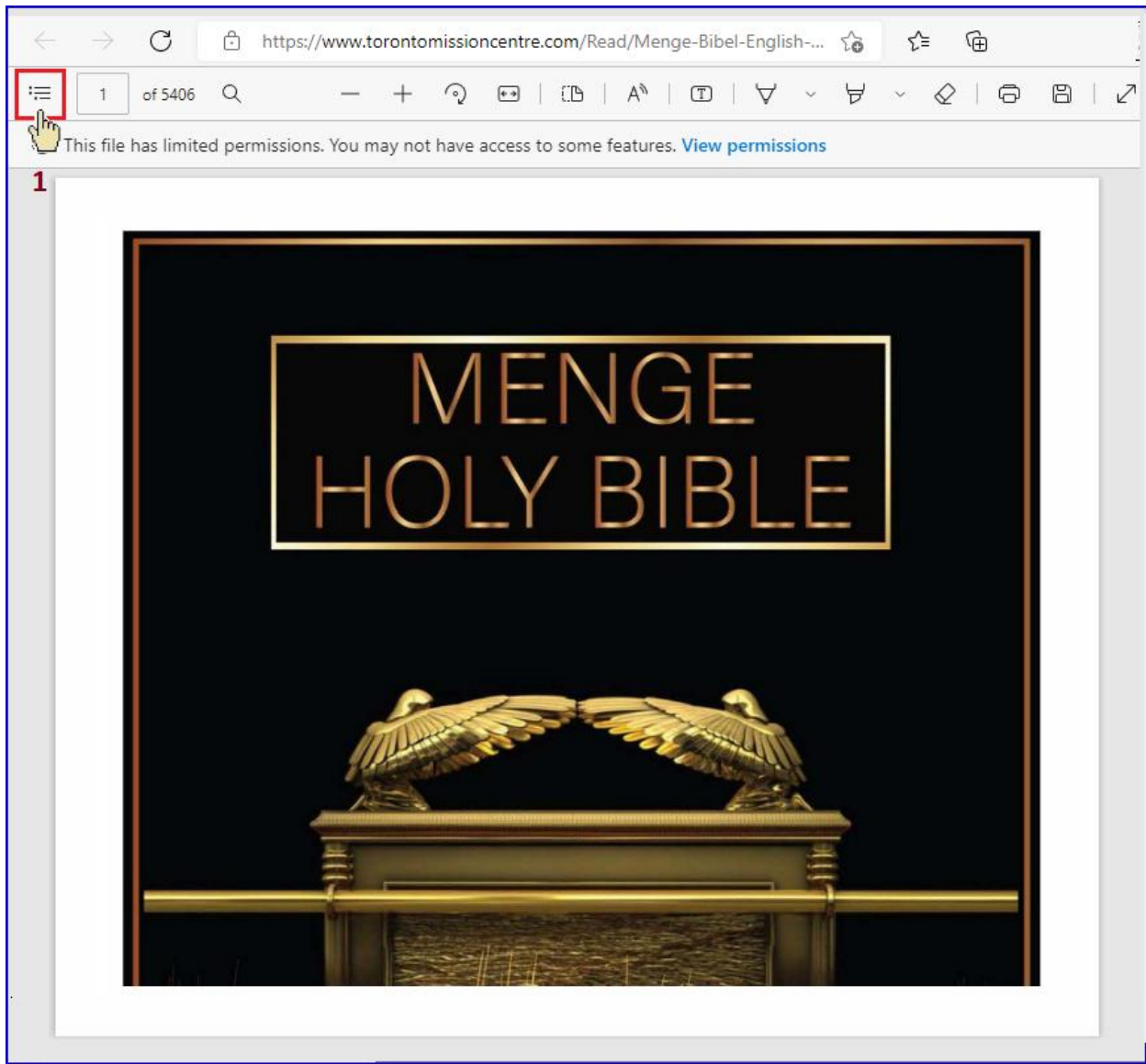
